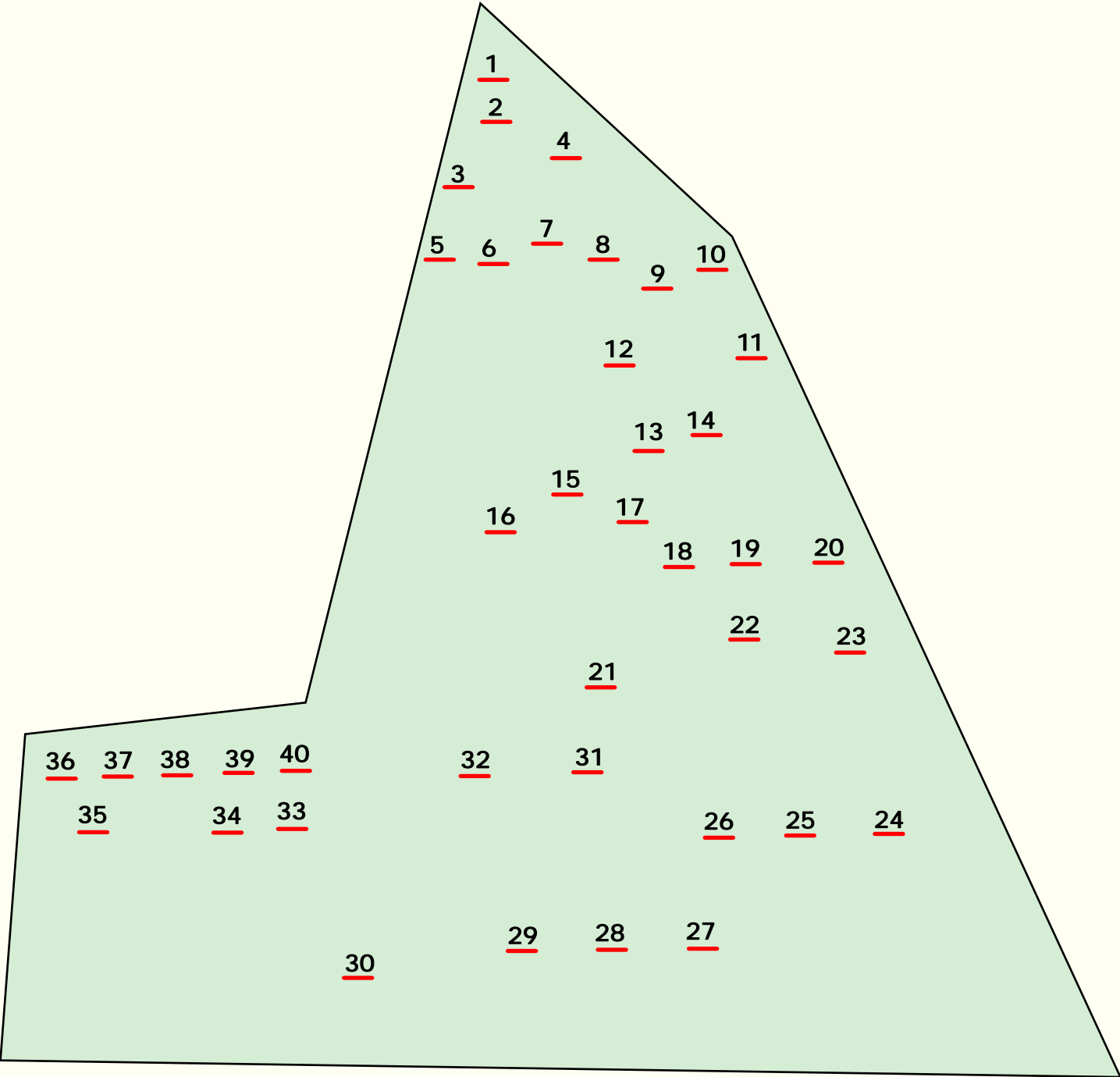

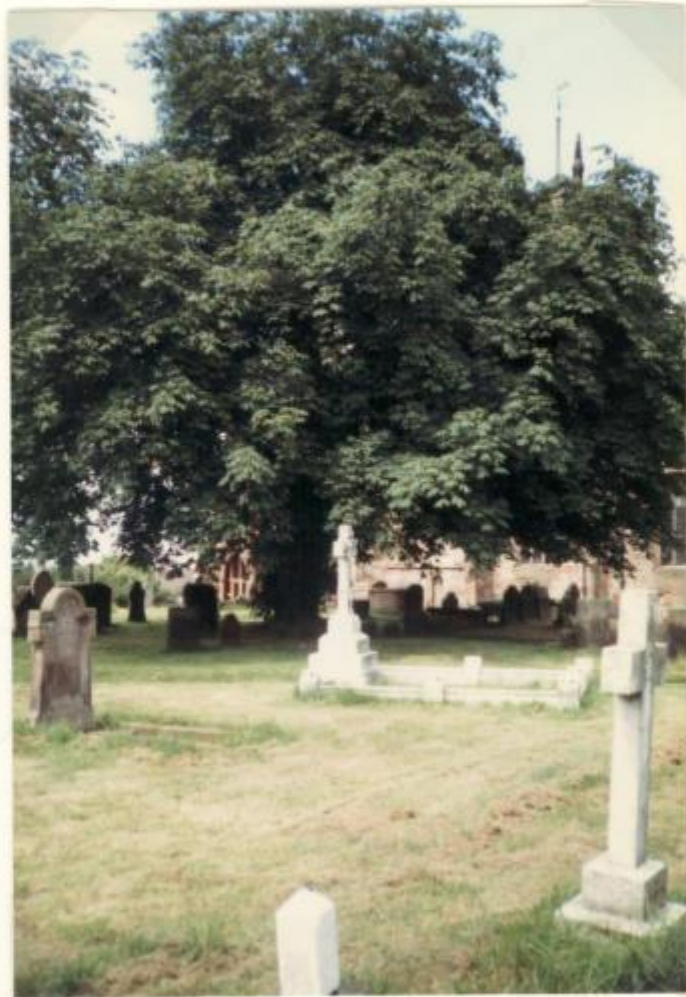




General View Area E



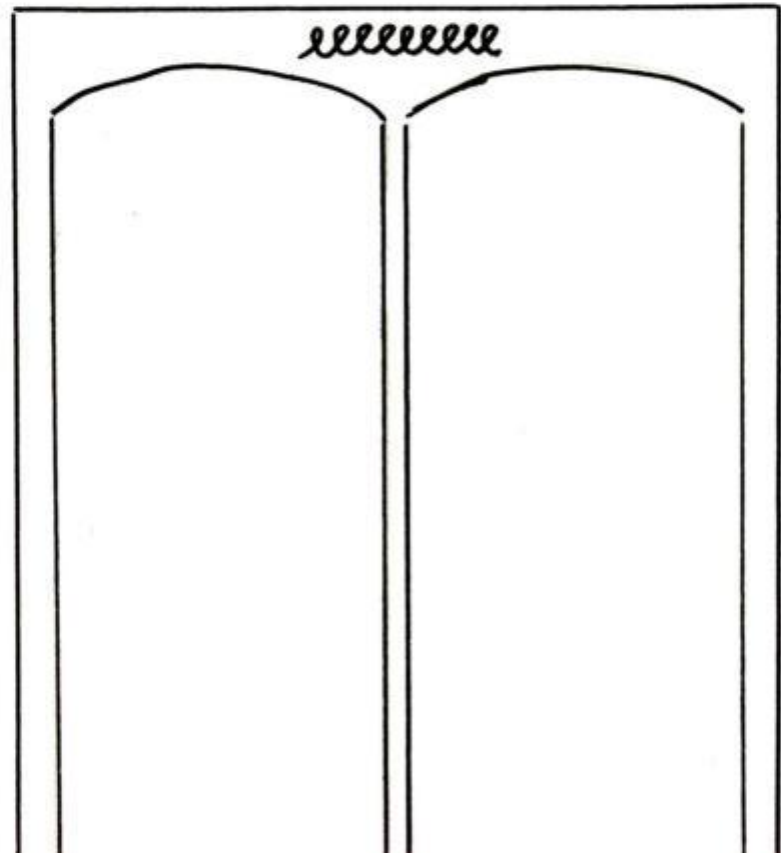

 other.



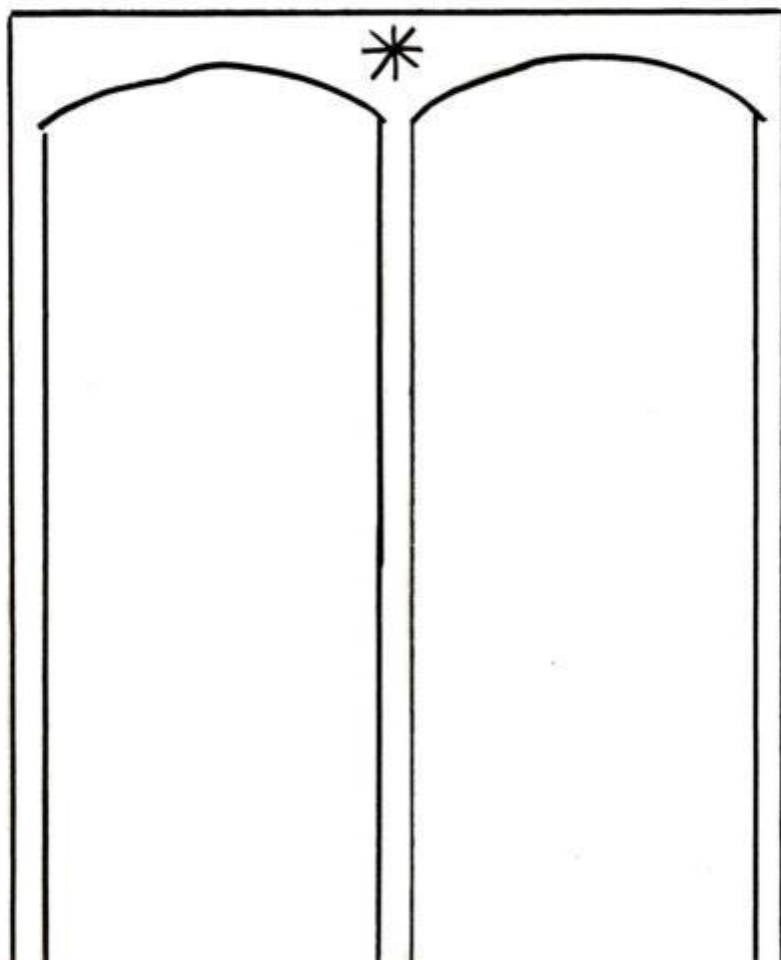

part no more

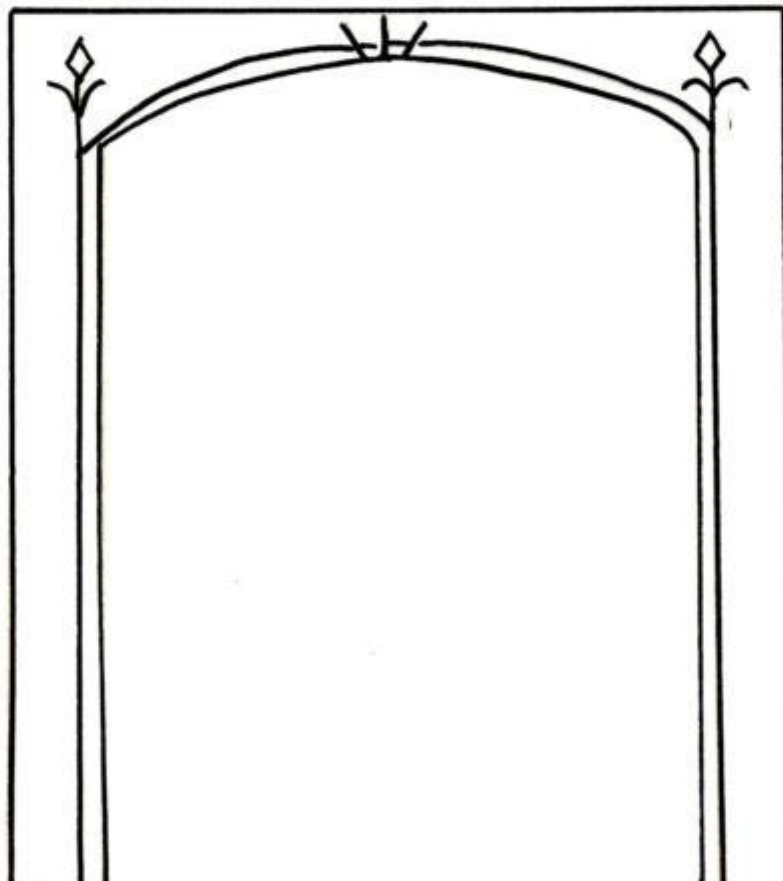

deeply to be seen.



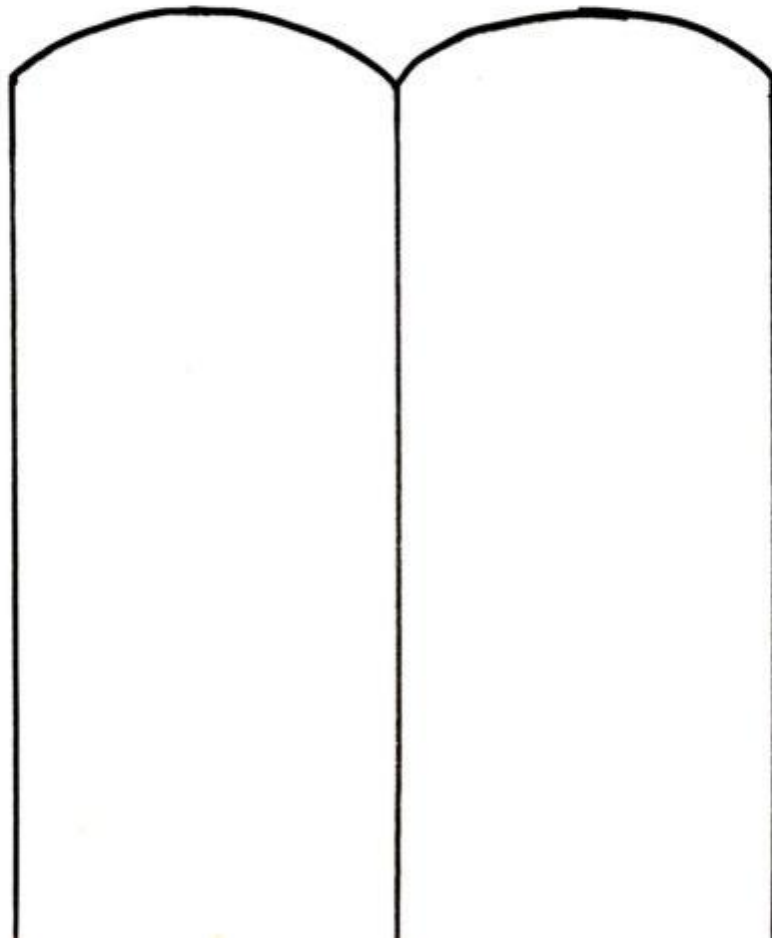

mistake of Gnosall.



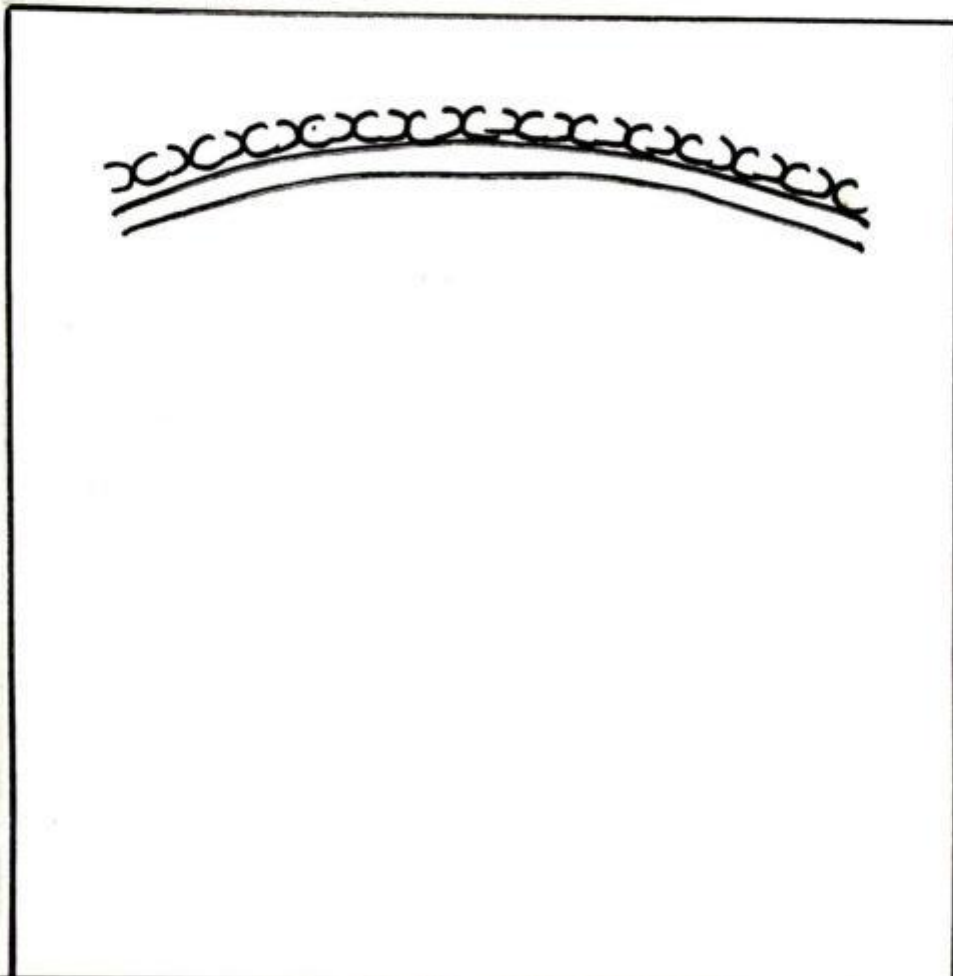

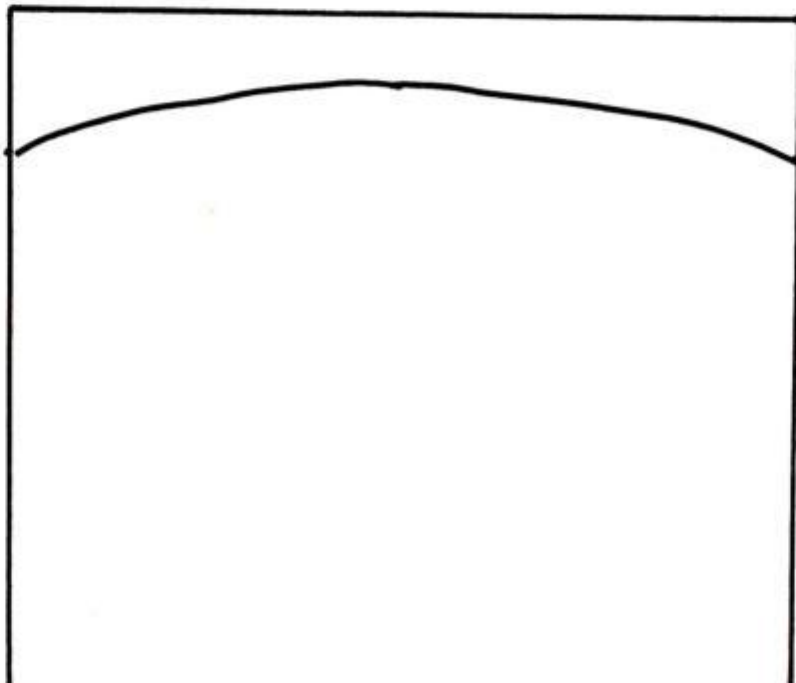

both buried in one grave

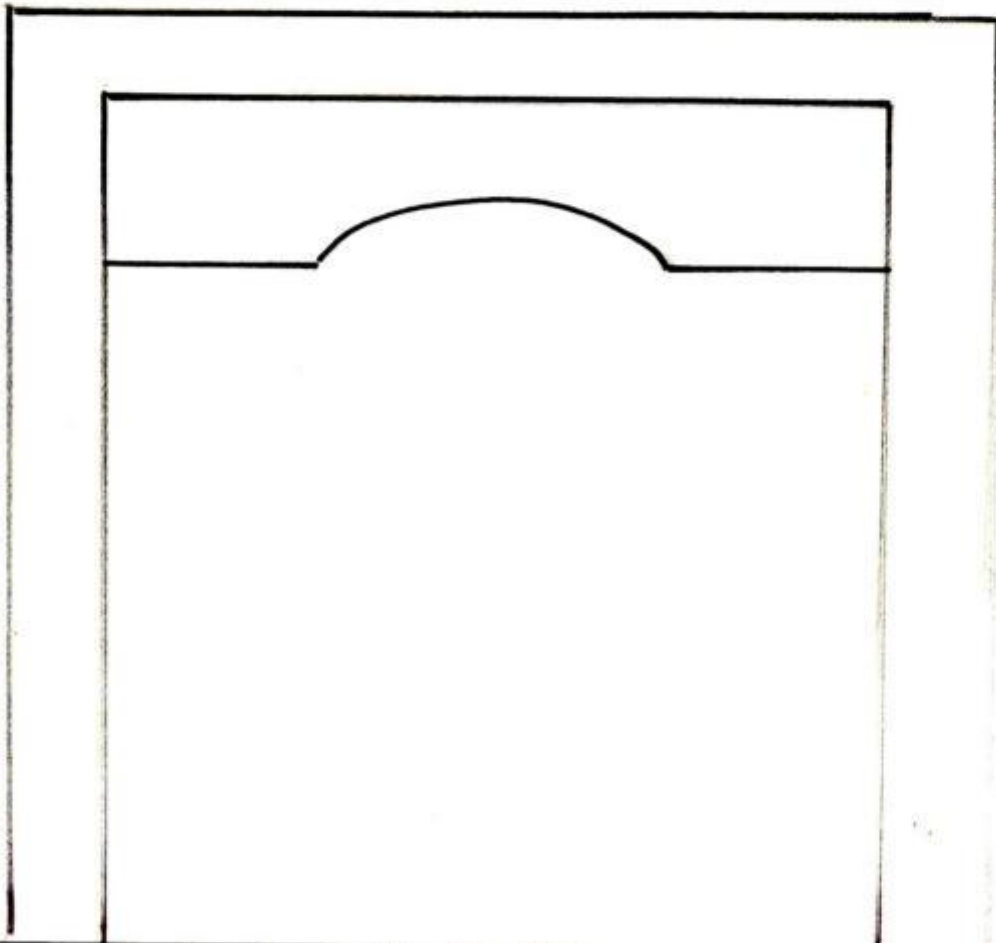
Facing West. Cooper is obviously the man's
