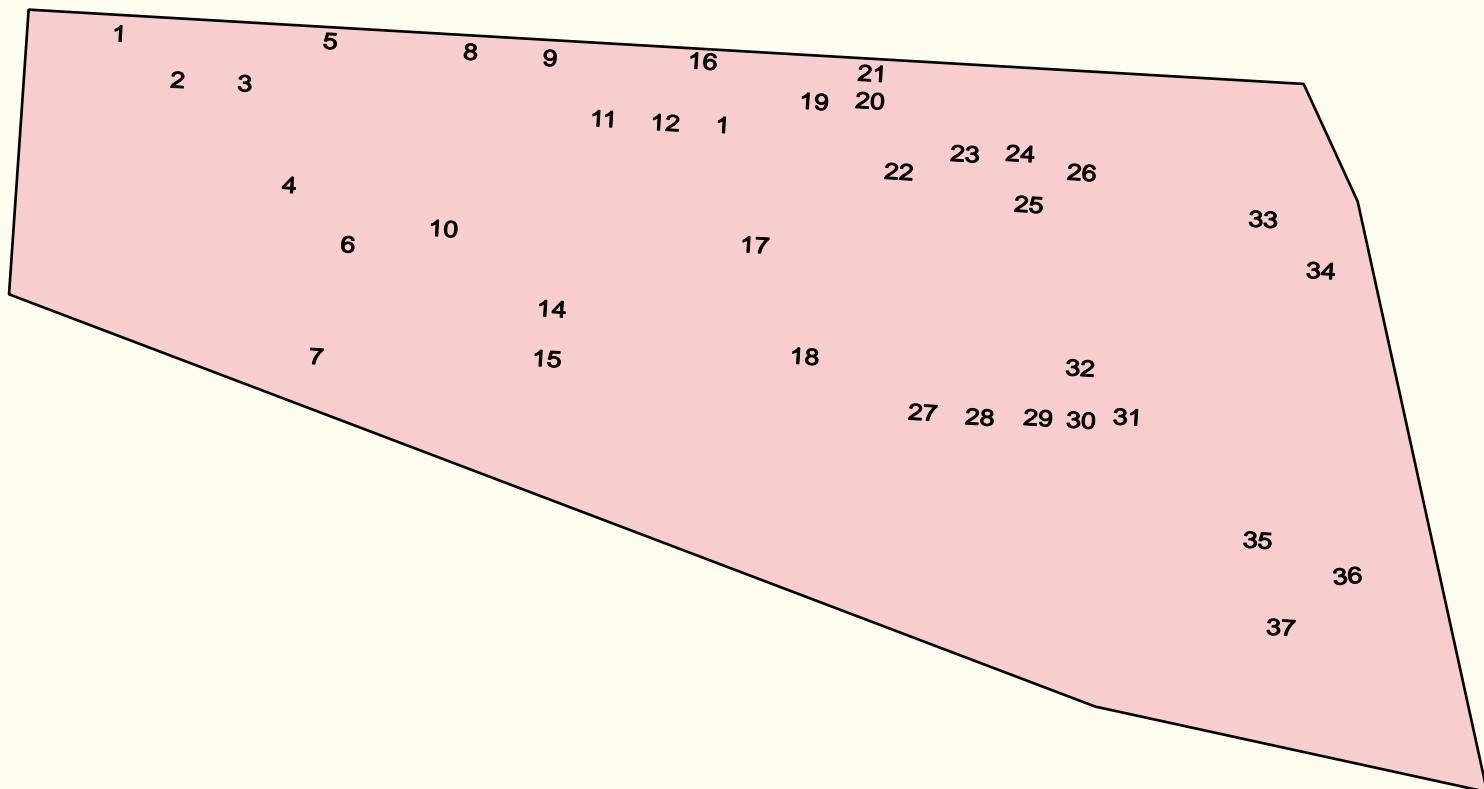

Views of Areas F and G



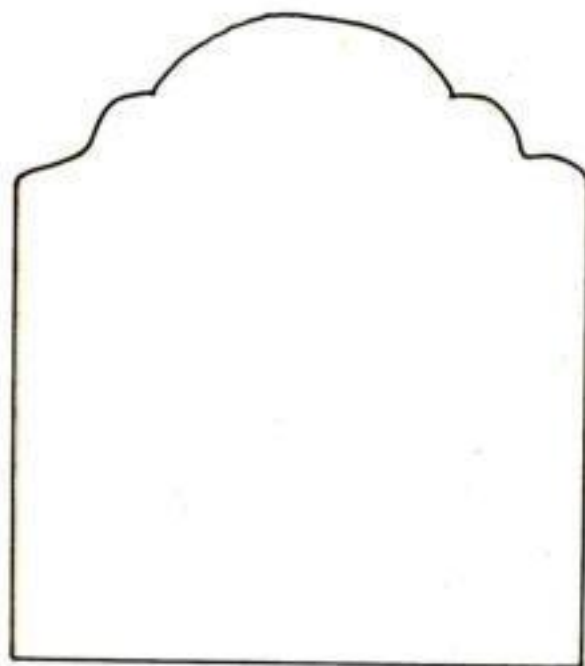
